### Holy Communion for those with Gluten

**Sensitivities**— A question was raised about the letter the Pope sent to bishops around the world regarding “gluten free” hosts. What Pope Francis wrote was that we could not use the term “gluten free,” as all hosts approved for the Liturgy do have at least a miniscule amount of gluten. In addition to our regular hosts, we do have special hosts that we refer to as “low gluten,” which have only **0.01% gluten**. These may be requested from any Eucharistic Minister before Mass starts. If you are unable to have **any** gluten, you may receive Communion in the form of the wine. Hopefully, this will clear up the confusion.
