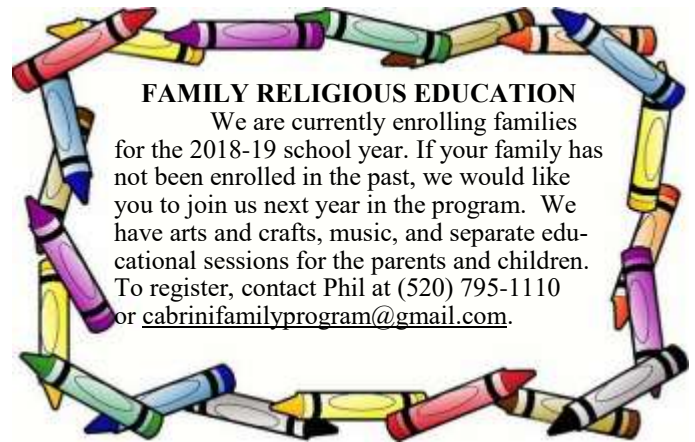
DO YOU CHEW GUM?
