We must trust the work of the Master's hand as we, the mustard plant, grow and grow.

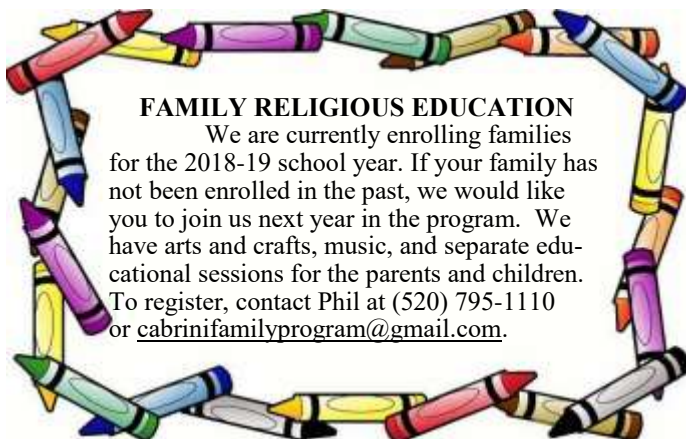


MOVIES AND PIZZA FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 6-12! BAKING TIME SOON!
