**REST IN
THE LORD**

For several weeks we have listened to readings that have recounted just how arduous the work of prophets and disciples can

be. In today's Gospel, the Lord Jesus listens to the reports of those he had sent out "two by two" to minister to the people. After the apostles reported what they had done, Jesus, recognizing their fatigue, says, "Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest awhile" (Mark 6:31). ASSISTING IMMIGRANT FAMILIES

Casa Alitas, a Program of Catholic Community Services, serves Central American families who have left their home countries to escape violence and poverty and seek asylum. In Arizona, the Border Patrol turns them over to Immigration and Customs Enforcement, which schedules them for immigration hearings and then drops them off at Casa Alitas (usually around 15 travelers a day). There they are given short-term shelter and help in reuniting with family members in the U.S.A. This often involves a trip on the Greyhound bus.

If you would like to help, donations that would be very much appreciated include the following: baby formula (powdered or liquid) in travel sizes, diaper wipes, laundry detergent, toothpaste and toothbrushes, combs and hairbrushes, juice pouches and snack foods suitable for bus rides — such as granola bars, nuts, raisins, fresh apples or cups/pouches of applesauce, sliced bread, peanut butter and jelly, crackers, etc. They can also use backpacks, small travel blankets, and new underwear and sneakers for men, women and children in small and medium sizes.
