own behavior. We don't like to be reproached for transgressions of the law or charged with violations of our training.

We may condemn and abuse those who bring us up against these truths about ourselves when, if we were really good, we would thank them for helping to keep us on the right path. This is the way they treated the prophets and the way they treated Jesus. Is this also the way we treat those whose message we don't like?

OUR RECYCLING BINS

The same faithful volunteer, now in his seventies, has taken the parish recycling bins to the curb every Sunday night since Tucson has had recycling bins. If there's been a parish event that week at which refreshments have been served, he has a mess to clean out because the bins are usually mainly full of ineligible items — cans, bottles and cups that still have liquid in them and must be emptied first, food waste that has fallen off paper plates (which are not recyclable, either, since once they're dirty, they're considered garbage), used paper napkins, plastic bags, and all kinds of other things not accepted by the recyclers. If you wouldn't put something in your home recycling bin, please don't put it in the church one! Use our blue recycling bins just for clean items that are eligible for curbside recycling. Please use our other garbage/trash containers for everything else. If you can't find a garbage/trash container, ask a staff member or longtime volunteer!
