REPORTING ABUSE/NEGLECT OF THE SICK AND ELDERLY

A person who reasonably believes that an elderly or sick adult is the victim of physical, emotional or financial abuse or neglect should call 9-1-1 if the person is in imminent danger. Whether or not 9-1-1 is called, the witness to the abuse or neglect should call Adult Protective Services at 1-877-767-2385. In addition, if anyone involved is part of our parish community, please notify the parish Compliance Officers, Terry and Donna Madden, through the parish office. Persons making reports do not have to prove the abuse/neglect and are exempt from liability as long as they are acting in good faith and not maliciously. Investigation and validation of a report is the responsibility of the Department of Adult Protective Services.
