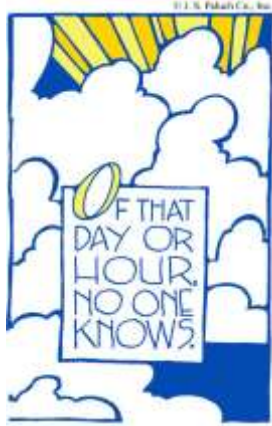

ENCOURAGEMENT
