AZ TAX CREDIT FOR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY

A dollar-for-dollar tax credit is available for your contributions to qualifying charitable organizations such as the St. Vincent de Paul Society. The tax credit is claimed on Form 321. Be sure to enter the code 20768 for St. Vincent de Paul at St. Frances Cabrini. The maximum credit allowed is \$800 for married filing joint filers and \$400 for single, heads of household, and married filing separate filers. This is separate from the CTSO credit. Please contact your tax advisor or see AZ Publication 710 for further details.



ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

The St. Vincent de Paul Society of our parish gives out food boxes to people in need who live in our church neighborhood throughout the year.

We always need staples like canned fruit, vegetables, tuna and soup, and other non-perishable items like

rice, dried pinto beans, pasta and pasta sauce, peanut butter, jelly, cereal, raisins, etc. We also have many requests for non-food basics like toilet paper and dish and bath soap, toothpaste and toothbrushes. Our blue barrels are usually out in the church to accept your gifts, or they may be dropped off at the parish office during the week. Thank you for helping others have bountiful food boxes.

If you prefer to make a monetary donation, we will use it to prevent people being evicted or having their gas or electricity cut off because they cannot afford to pay the whole amount. If you'd like to volunteer with us, call the parish office at 326-7670.

The amount you can now contribute to Arizona's Catholic Tuition Support Organization (CTSO) has increased. Single filers can give up to \$1,107, and a married couple filing jointly can contribute up to \$2,213 and receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit off your Arizona tax liability.
