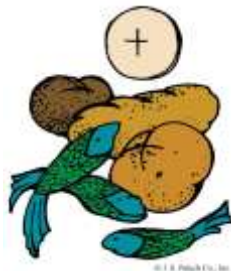
TODAY'S READINGS
