CATHOLIC DIVORCE HEALING PROGRAM

Find comfort and counsel consistent with Catholic Church teachings. *Surviving Divorce* groups are starting soon in two Tucson locations. The cost of \$25 per person includes all program materials. The program runs for 12 weeks and features video presentations on topics including shock and grief, anger and forgiveness, money issues, dealing with children and a former spouse, and annulment and remarriage. There is a guidebook to accompany the videos. This program is for those who are newly separated and divorced and for those still struggling with issues many years later. It will help them find answers to their questions, restore their hope, and begin authentic healing. A group begins on Sept. 4 at St. Pius X Parish and another begins Sept. 10 at the Diocesan Pastoral Center next to St. Augustine Cathedral. Groups close after the 3rd week and space is limited, so reserve your space now. Sorry, we do not have onsite child care.
