

### THIS IS MY BELOVED SON

This Sunday's celebration of the Baptism of the Lord closes the Christmas season. In the scriptures we see one more epiphany, or manifestation, of the Spirit of God in Jesus—but this time it is as an adult, rather than as a child. Jesus' baptism also serves as the inauguration of his prophetic mission and the messianic age.

Today's reading

from Isaiah describes God's chosen Messiah, upon whom God's spirit rests. In the Acts of the Apostles Peter says that "God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power" (Acts 10:38). Finally, in the proclamation from Matthew's Gospel Jesus' baptism in water goes almost unnoticed. The crucial moment comes when the Spirit of God comes upon Jesus and a voice from heaven echoes the words of Isaiah: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased" (Matthew 3:17).



# 2019 CONTRIBUTION STATEMENTS **COMING SOON**

The 2019 contribution statements will be ready by the end of January. If you contributed \$100 or more in total to St. Frances Cabrini parish in 2019, we will mail your statement to you. If you contributed less than \$100 total, you may call the office and one will be sent at your request. When you receive your statement, if you believe it contains an error, or if you would like something explained, please call the office (326-7670) and ask for Eileen.

One common question is "What is Fund 9?" Fund 9 is for extra contributions beyond the regular weekly or monthly ones — Holy Day contributions, Choir Fund contributions or poinsettias bought for the church are examples. We can furnish a breakdown of these. The parish St. Vincent de Paul Society sends out its own statements, however. Also, the Diocese of Tucson keeps records of your individual contributions to the Annual Catholic Appeal; our office does not.
