SEEKING THE LIGHT

In today's readings we find ourselves being drawn more deeply into relationship with Jesus. We are getting to know more about him as we see how he struggles with the news of his cousin John's arrest. His first response is to withdraw, to leave Nazareth and go to Capernaum. There he is perhaps both consoled and challenged by the words of Isaiah that Matthew quotes: "the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light, / on those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death / light has arisen" (Matthew 4:16). Jesus contemplates his cousin's death, perhaps his own death, and he seeks the light. Maybe it is these words of Isaiah that move Jesus out of his withdrawal and into action. He begins to preach, teach, cure disease and illness, and proclaim the gospel of the kingdom.

REASONS TO REGISTER

If you come to church here regularly but are not registered as a member of the parish, we would appreciate it if you would either go to our website and register online or contact our office to get a registration form. The information we collect is confidential. Here are some reasons to register (and update your registration form when things change in your household):

- 1) Because our diocese needs an accurate count of how many households and individual Catholics are in each parish;
- 2) So we can send you parish mailings, such as letters with the schedule of events during the Christmas and Easter seasons;
- 3) To be eligible for certain services we provide, such as a letter on your behalf to be a baptismal sponsor (godparent), for example;
- 4) In case you want to volunteer with one of our programs, since volunteers need to be registered members;
- 5) So we have emergency contact information in case something happens to you on parish property;
- 6) So you get the member rate for use of our buildings for various events.

Please note that registering as a parish member does not obligate you to receive collection envelopes or make regular electronic donations, although of course we do appreciate it if you are able to help support the parish with financial contributions, and we are happy to arrange for collection envelopes to be sent or to set up monthly or weekly electronic donations.
