

Lent is all about change and change is usually not easy. In order to change we have to leave something behind. Today we hear about a very old man who decides to answer God's call. Abram experiences a tremen-

dous amount of change when he leaves everything behind, risking it all for God's promise. Jesus changes, is transfigured, right before the eyes of his disciples. The Lenten scriptures issue the call for us to change, to be transfigured, so that we, too, will

OUR PARISH TO RECEIVE CATHOLIC FOUNDATION GRANT

St. Frances Cabrini Parish applied for and will receive a \$10,000 grant to be presented at the



Catholic Foundation's Grant Award Ceremony on March 27th. The Catholic Foundation for the Diocese of Tucson will give 56 grants this year, supporting various parishes, schools and Diocesan ministries. One of the things we wrote the grant to pay for is to replace the fluorescent light fixtures in the parish office. A few months ago, one of them exploded, and the electrician said all are unstable due to age and should be replaced. Thankfully, no one was hurt, but the carpet in the office was badly damaged. The outdated phone & Internet system in the office and other parish buildings also no longer worked very well, and we are replacing it. Knowing the state of parish finances, Connie Bracamonte, our Office Manager, applied for a grant to pay for these much-needed improvements. Grants to parishes in need are just one of the many things you support when you contribute to the Annual Catholic Appeal. We are grateful for their support and hope the members of our parish will continue to support the ACA.
