

FOOD FROM HEAVEN

God sustained the people of Israel for forty years in the desert with manna sent down from heaven, and Moses

doesn't want them to forget it. God brought forth water from stone for them to drink, and Moses doesn't want them to forget this, either. And Moses tells them—twice—that the food that God sent was a food that neither they nor their ancestors before them had ever experienced before.

Jesus too speaks of food come down from heaven, food that the Jewish people had never experienced before. Recalling the manna in the desert, Jesus doesn't want them to forget it either, explaining that he is the food and drink of eternal life. And Paul reiterates to the Corinthians and to all of us that in the bread and in the cup, we share in the body and blood of Christ.

NEWS

Out of concern for keeping us all safe, our bishop has not yet authorized a general and total re-opening of all parishes. Check www.diocesetucson.org, the website of the Diocese of Tucson, for ongoing news.

Due to the large number of members of our parish who are senior citizens (including our pastor and most of our liturgical ministers), many of whom have underlying health conditions, we need to put a lot of thought into carefully planning our gatherings. Some parishes will open sooner than we do. We are in the process of working out the logistics of having Masses and other gatherings here in the safest possible manner while the death rate from COVID-19 continues to rise in our state.

Although we do not yet think it safe to hold Masses or any other large group gatherings indoors, starting the weekend of May 23-24, with the bishop's approval, we began the practice of distribution of Holy Communion in the west parking lot of St. Frances Cabrini Church at the following times: 5:00 to 5:20 p.m. on Saturday, and 8:30 to 8:50 and 10:00 to 10:20 a.m. on Sunday. This will happen each weekend until further notice. We ask that everyone please wear masks, stay in your vehicles, and follow the signs for traffic flow. As you drive beside where he is standing, near the northwest church entrance, our pastor, Fr. Jay, who will be wearing mask and gloves, will reach through your open window and hand you the number of consecrated hosts required for the people in your car who wish to receive it. We particularly rejoice to share Holy Communion on the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ.

A parish member with a collection basket, in mask and gloves, will be standing some distance south of Fr. Jay to receive any offering envelopes people may wish to bring. Please do not get out of your vehicle; put the envelope in the basket through your window.

Fr. Jay has been sending weekly letters to all parish members for whom we have email addresses. When we are ready to further expand services at our parish, he will let you know in an upcoming letter, and we will also put the information in the bulletin, which we post on our parish website. If we don't have your email address and you would like to receive these letters by email, please contact us at cabrinil962@aol.com.

If you know someone who does not have Internet access and who might like to be mailed paper copies of Fr. Jay's letters and/or our bulletins, ask them to call the office (326-7670) and let us know. We will be happy to send them.
