

#### WHY PRAY?

The "foreigners" as Isaiah calls them, the "Gentiles" as Paul calls them, or the "Canaanites" as Matthew calls them are called to worship the one true God in prayer. As we listen to today's readings, perhaps we are tempted to ask:

Why pray? The question is rhetorical; it is tantamount to asking why should friends talk to one another or people in love kiss one another. Prayer is a way of relating to God, a way of talking to God. The apostles had the opportunity to talk to Jesus in the flesh. We have the opportunity to talk to Jesus Christ in prayer. Our relationship with him must be enthusiastic; it cannot be faint-hearted. John Donne, a fifteenth-century poet, knew what the qualities of good prayer were. Donne asks God to treat him differently from most Christians. The poet does not want God to merely "knock, breathe, shine, and seek to mend," but also to "break, blow, burn, and make me new" (Holy Sonnets, XIV).

It takes a dynamic faith on our part to come to God in prayer. As Jesus once said, "Knock and the door will be opened to you" (Matthew 7:7). It may take pounding the door down, but if we are as persistent as the woman in today's Gospel, the results will follow.

#### **NEWS**

While some parishes in Tucson, as of Aug. 7th, will have indoor Masses, our Bishop recommends that persons at high risk do not attend them. As our parish has a high proportion of such persons, including our pastor, we will not have indoor Mass yet. The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass in person remains in place. Per the Bishop's recommendation, we distribute Holy Communion on a drive-through basis in the west parking lot of St. Frances Cabrini Church at the following times: 5:00 to 5:20 p.m. on Saturday, and 8:30 to 8:50 and 10:00 to 10:20 a.m. on Sunday. Please wear masks, stay in your vehicles, and follow the signs for traffic flow. As you drive beside where he is standing, near the northwest church entrance, Fr. Jay or one of the Eucharistic Ministers, wearing mask and gloves, will reach through your open window and hand you the number of consecrated hosts needed for the people in your car who wish to receive it.

Fr. Jay has been sending weekly letters to all parish members for whom we have email addresses. When we are able to further expand services at our parish, he will let you know in an upcoming letter, and we will also put the information in the bulletin, which is posted on our parish website, <a href="https://www.cabrinitucson.org">www.cabrinitucson.org</a>. If we don't have your email address and you would like to receive these letters by email, please contact us at <a href="mailto:cabrini1962@aol.com">cabrini1962@aol.com</a>.

If you know someone who does not have Internet access and who might like to be mailed paper copies of Fr. Jay's letters and/or our bulletins, ask them to call the office (326-7670) and let us know.

To arrange for the Sacrament of Penance (Confession), call the parish office. Fr. Jay will take appointments for Confession on Thursday mornings between 9:00 and noon and on Fridays from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. His letter of July 2 explains the protocol we will follow for your safety and his.

# UPDATE ON SR. JOSE WOMEN'S CENTER


The Center, which serves homeless women, has slowly reopened. Guests who come to the door are met with a sack lunch,



water, hygiene products and free cloth masks. Volunteers do laundry for them and allow a few to come in for showers, widely spaced and cleaning in between, although they are not yet open for overnight guests. When they do, plans will be for much greater spacing between beds. Many long-time volunteers have had to step back because they were vulnerable to COVID-19, but those "First Responders" who meet guests at the door have received additional training in health and safety protocols and must follow strict guidelines. It is with great gratitude that the Center salutes their volunteers and the generous donors who have provided much needed funds, masks and hygiene items.
