


TRUST

Keys hold great significance for those who carry them. They represent the trust and authority of the owner when given to another person. We may give our house key to a trusted friend to take care of our matters while we are away. We may give

keys to someone responsible for maintaining or working in a particular building. Keys to vehicles are given to people who have proven themselves responsible drivers. The readings today focus on this kind of trust—the trust that conveys authority and responsibility. In the first reading, the symbol is specifically that of a key; but the second reading and the Gospel also speak of trust and leadership as they refer to the

NEWS

While some parishes in Tucson, as of Aug. 7th, will have indoor Masses, our Bishop recommends that persons at high risk do not attend them. As our parish has a high proportion of such persons, including our pastor, we will not have indoor Mass yet. The dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass in person remains in place. Per the Bishop's recommendation, we distribute Holy Communion on a drive-through basis in the west parking lot of St. Frances Cabrini Church at the following times: 5:00 to 5:20 p.m. on Saturday, and 8:30 to 8:50 and 10:00 to 10:20 a.m. on Sunday. Please wear masks, stay in your vehicles, and follow the signs for traffic flow. As you drive beside where he is standing, near the northwest church entrance, Fr. Jay or one of the Eucharistic Ministers, wearing mask and gloves, will reach through your open window and hand you the number of consecrated hosts needed for the people in your car who wish to receive it.

Fr. Jay has been sending weekly letters to all parish members for whom we have email addresses. When we are able to further expand services at our parish, he will let you know in an upcoming letter, and we will also put the information in the bulletin, which is posted on our parish website, www.cabrinitucson.org. If we don't have your email address and you would like to receive these letters by email, please contact us at cabrini1962@aol.com.

If you know someone who does not have Internet access and who might like to be mailed paper copies of Fr. Jay's letters and/or our bulletins, ask them to call the office (326-7670) and let us know.

To arrange for the Sacrament of Penance (Confession), call the parish office. Fr. Jay will take appointments for Confession on Thursday mornings between 9:00 and noon and on Fridays from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. His letter of July 2 explains the protocol we will follow for your safety and his.

Those who wish to donate financially to our Conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society can mail a donation to the parish office, put it in an envelope in the basket at the Communion service, or put it through the mail slot in the parish office door. If you have non-perishable food (or necessary household basics like toilet paper) to donate, call our pantry at 881-3075. Leave a message if no one picks up. We will return your call and make an arrangement to collect the food and other items. Some suggestions for the most needed items include canned soups, tuna, chicken, vegetables and fruit; also rice, pasta & pasta sauce, dried or canned beans, boxed cereals, peanut butter, toilet paper, dish soap, hand or bath soap and toothpaste.
