

With satisfied resignation Bill introduced himself not by name: “I’m Ellen’s Dad.”


It’s good to know who you are. Be it someone’s father or mother, son or daughter, husband or wife, it’s important to embrace the full meaning of our various roles.

Coming to Mass:

In this phase of re-opening, we are trying to minimize physical contact to avoid spreading the COVID-19 virus, in case anyone in our congregation has it without showing symptoms. (If you do feel ill, please stay home and call your doctor!) Please wear a mask. Please allow a Hospitality Minister to find you a seat, so that we can have proper physical distancing.

Holy Communion will be distributed by Eucharistic Ministers as we leave the church. Baskets for contributions will be at the two open exits, to avoid passing them.

Confessions: Confessions are currently suspended until further notice.

Parish Office: If you need in-person service, please call ahead (326-7670) to be sure someone will be here. For now, we are staggering our hours so staff can minimize contact, even with each other. Someone will meet you at the door to give you the materials you need. We do not invite people into the office. Please wear a mask; we will do so as well.


