

#### **IESUS' WAY**

Today's readings present a contrast between "Jesus' way" and the "old way." An example of the old way is the law given to Moses and Aaron about leprosy: the leper was unclean and cast out of the community. Jesus' way is the opposite: the leper is reached out to, touched, and finally cured.

Nor ought we think of the "old way" as restricted to the days of Moses and Aaron, or even to the "old" testament. The difference between the old way and Jesus' way arises in own lives. We still choose, every day, to live in our old way or in Jesus' way.

Jesus dared to touch a leper, disregarding the old way. The leper then was changed forever. He felt a calling. He couldn't keep himself from proclaiming that he had been touched by Jesus (even though Jesus told him not to!). Once Jesus touches us, we are called to proclaim his way. Copyright © J. S. #### **Our Current Services**

While we are not having public Masses at this time, our parish will continue to have the Saturday evening drive-through distribution of Holy Communion in the west parking lot of the church. This takes place from 5:00 p.m. to approximately 5:20 p.m.

Please enter the parking lot from the entrance closest to the Rectory on Presidio Rd., drive behind the Hall and Education Building, and from there to the northwest entrance of the church. If you roll down your window (please wear a mask if this is possible for you), Fr. Jay or another Eucharistic Minister, wearing a protective mask, will hand you the blessed hosts for as many people as are in your vehicle. On the way out through the marked exit, a volunteer will also have a basket for financial contributions. The first Sat. of each month we will also have the blue barrel for St. Vincent de Paul items available.

On Ash Wed., Feb. 17, we will have drive-through distribution of ashes in the parking lot at 5:00 p.m. Fr. Jay and a lay minister will be on opposite sides of the vehicles going through, so as to easily give ashes to everyone in the vehicle who rolls down their window. Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of Obligation, but it is a treasured Catholic tradition which marks our turning toward the holy season of Lent.

The parish office is closed to the general public. If you need something from the office, please call ahead on a weekday to make sure someone is there. We will make arrangements to meet you, masked, at the door to assist you. We will be unable to invite you inside. Fr. Jay sends weekly letters via email to everyone for whom we have email addresses. In addition to posting them on the parish website, we also send Father's letters and this bulletin by regular mail to those who request them. Call (520) 326-7670 and leave a message. We will be happy to send either or both of these to you.

## Fasting and Abstinence During Lent

The following information

comes from the website of the U.S. Council of Catholic Bishops. Ash Wed. and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence.

For members of the Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that are not equal to a full meal.
