TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading — They were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak in different tongues (Acts 2:1-11).

Per diocesan protocols, given the size of our church, attendance at indoor services is limited to 70 persons, to have social distancing. Masks are still required.

At this time, we distribute Holy Communion at the end of Mass, at the west doors. Plans are in the works, however, to return distribution of the Eucharist to its usual time in the Mass. We will let you know when that is decided. Please allow social distancing while waiting to receive the Eucharist.

We will not pass collection baskets during Masses, but will have them at the west doors of the church at the end of each Mass. A collection basket will also be available at the Drive-Through Communion Service. A volunteer will have it a few car lengths past where Father Jay distributes the Eucharist on the west side of the church.

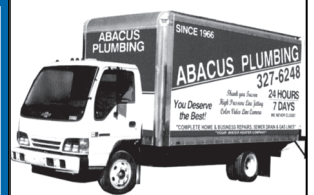
