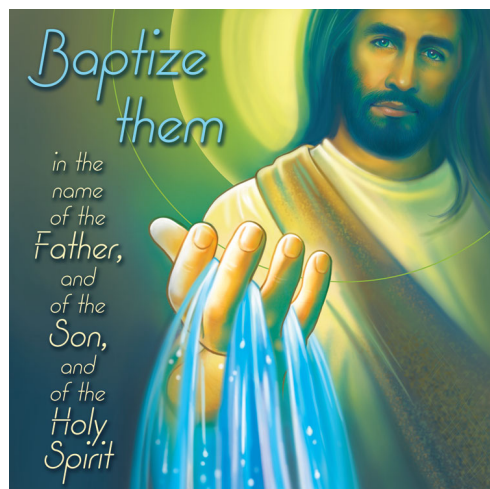

### THE MYSTERY OF THE BLESSED TRINITY

Today we celebrate the solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. The Church sets aside this Sunday to focus our attention on the mystery of the Blessed Trinity, God who is

one, but three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

The first reading from Deuteronomy emphasizes both God's awesome greatness and amazing nearness. It might seem beyond belief, but the God of all creation speaks to us, protects us, and guides us. The second reading from Saint Paul's Letter to the Romans describes how we are to relate to the three persons who are one God. We are led by the Spirit to meet God the Father as adopted children. Our adoption is such that we are even heirs with our brother, Christ, the second person of the Trinity, in whose sufferings we must also share. In Matthew's Gospel, Jesus speaks with his authority as God and sends us to teach and baptize in the name of the Trinity.

**Please note that protocols are different at the Saturday and Sunday Masses.** At the 3:30 Saturday Mass, we will continue to require face masks and social distancing of at least six feet. Therefore, this Mass is suitable for those who are not yet fully vaccinated and/or are uncomfortable with a lack of social distancing.

Those who are fully vaccinated and wish to attend one of the two Sunday Masses will no longer need to wear face masks or observe the six-foot social distancing requirement. You can sit now next to your friends! If you will feel more comfortable continuing to wear a mask at Sunday Mass, however, you are welcome to do so.

Holy Communion will be distributed at the traditional time at all Masses and will be the Body of Christ only, received in the hand only. The Eucharistic Ministers will distribute it from the rows with yellow caution tape on the seats. These are every other row of seats in the church. Please do not sit in these seats at any of the Masses.

Father Jay will continue to have the drive-through distribution of Holy Communion outside the west patio of the church at 5:00 on Sat. for those who wish to continue to receive the Eucharist in this manner.

By offering these different ways to attend Mass and receive the Eucharist, we hope to serve as many people's spiritual needs as possible.

**NEW MASS TIME ADDED ON SATURDAYS**

Beginning May 29th, Fr. Jay will preside at a Mass at 3:30 p.m. on Saturdays. It is being held at 3:30 so that Fr. Jay can continue to offer the drive-through Holy Communion Service at 5:00 p.m. on Saturdays, which is still well attended, so we believe the need for it remains. In order to have Masses that are suitable for vaccinated persons and unvaccinated persons, we are having different protocols for the Saturday and Sunday Masses — please see the explanation of them on the facing page.

**FR. JAY IS RETIRING —****NEW PARISH ADMINISTRATOR NAMED**

Fr. Jay, who turned 70 in April, will be retiring as of June 30, 2021. Bishop Weisenburger has appointed a new parish administrator for St. Frances Cabrini Parish, effective July 1st. He is Fr. Balaswamy ("Fr. Bala") Kommathoti, who has been one of the associate pastors at Sts. Peter and Paul parish and will continue to be in residence there. The Bishop's letter of May 18, posted on the website, explains a possible plan for our parish at some future time yet to be determined. Fr. Bala will be responsible for general pastoral care, Masses, and parish administration until a permanent future plan is established for the parish.

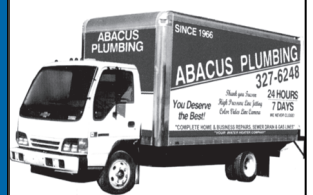
