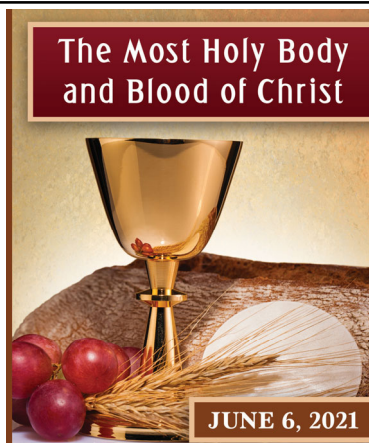
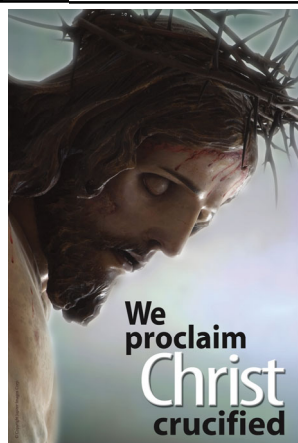

Please note that protocols are different at the Saturday and Sunday Masses. At the 3:30 Saturday Mass,

we will continue to require face masks and social distancing of at least six feet. Therefore, this Mass is suitable for those who are not yet fully vaccinated and/or are uncomfortable with a lack of social distancing.

Those who are fully vaccinated and wish to attend one of the two Sunday Masses will no longer need to wear face masks or observe the six-foot social distancing requirement. You can sit now next to your friends! If you will feel more comfortable continuing to wear a mask at Sunday Mass, however, you are welcome to do so.

Holy Communion will be distributed at the traditional time at all Masses and will be the Body of Christ only, received in the hand only. The Eucharistic Ministers will distribute it from the rows with yellow caution tape on the seats. These are every other row of seats in the church. Please do not sit in these seats at any of the Masses.

Father Jay will continue to have the drive-through distribution of Holy Communion outside the west patio of the church at 5:00 on Sat. for those who wish to continue to receive the Eucharist in this manner.

By offering these different ways to attend Mass and receive the Eucharist, we hope to serve as many people as possible.

SACRIFICE

Today the Church focuses on the Eucharist. Today's readings remind us how connected to ancient blood sacrifices we are when offering our unbloody sacrifice. The reading from Exodus describes a solemn ritual designed so the Israelites would never forget their covenant with God.

The reading from the Letter to the Hebrews turns us from those ancient animal sacrifices, the first efforts to worship the living God. Our sacrifice is the body and blood of the Son of God. Because of Christ we have a new covenant.

The Gospel from Mark retells the establishment of that covenant, the familiar story of the Last Supper. Juxtaposed with the story of animal sacrifice as it is here, we are challenged to listen with new attention, to remember the great price paid for our salvation. Jesus gave his body and every drop of his blood for us.

NEW MASS TIME ADDED ON SATURDAYS

Beginning May 29th, Fr. Jay will preside at a Mass at 3:30 p.m. on Saturdays. It is being held at 3:30 so that Fr. Jay can continue to offer the drive-through Holy Communion Service at 5:00 p.m. on Saturdays, which is still well attended, so we believe the need for it remains. FR. JAY IS RETIRING —**NEW PARISH ADMINISTRATOR NAMED**

Fr. Jay, who turned 70 in April, will be retiring as of June 30, 2021. Bishop Weisenburger has appointed a new parish administrator for St. Frances Cabrini Parish, effective July 1st. He is Fr. Balaswamy ("Fr. Bala") Kommathoti, who has been one of the associate pastors at Sts. Peter and Paul parish and will continue to be in residence there. The Bishop's letter of May 18, posted on the website, explains a possible plan for our parish at some future time yet to be determined. Fr. Bala will be responsible for general pastoral care, Masses, and parish administration until a permanent future plan is established for the parish.

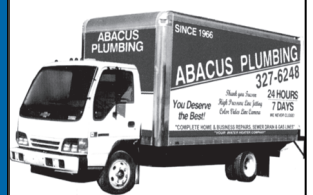
