

#### Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time July 11, 2021

#### GOD CHOSE US

Who chose first, God or you? That is the question explored in today's three readings. The second reading, from Paul's Letter to the Ephesians, reads almost like a hymn. It praises God for choosing us, for calling us to serve, and for blessing us in our service. Paul makes it clear how honored we are and how special is the call to live as children of God. This is



through no doing of our own.

The first reading and the Gospel use prose rather than poetry to describe the same truth: God did the choosing, not us. When the prophet Amos was berated for being a prophet, he retorted that the whole thing wasn't his idea in the first place. Neither did the twelve apostles in today's Gospel ask for their calling. Please note that protocols are different at the Saturday and Sunday Masses.

At the <u>5:00 Saturday Mass</u>, we will continue to require face masks and social distancing of at least six feet for those not of the same household. Therefore, this Mass is suitable for those who are not yet fully vaccinated and/or those who wish to continue to observe these safety precautions for any other reasons. The Bishop has asked all parishes to have one Mass where safety precautions are still observed. Therefore, if you come to this Mass, <u>please</u> do not make other people uncomfortable by refusing to follow the protocols for this Mass. You will not be asked to follow these precautions at the other Masses.

Those who are fully vaccinated and wish to attend one of the <u>two Sunday Masses</u> will no longer be required to wear face masks or observe the six-foot social distancing requirement. You can sit now next to your friends! If you will feel more comfortable continuing to wear a mask at Sunday Mass, however, you are welcome to do so.

DAILY MASSES WILL RESUME IN THE NEAR FUTURE! We are looking to set up a schedule of Readers for an 8:00 Mass on weekday mornings, except Monday (Fr. Bala's day off). Please contact the parish office if you are a Lector/ Commentator who would be willing and available to be a Reader at the 8:00 weekday Masses. We will make the announcement in this bulletin and through the parish email tree when it has been decided when these Masses will resume.
