

WHAT IS THIS PARISH CALLED NOW?

At the present time, the official name of our parish remains "St. Frances Cabrini Parish." However, Bishop Weisenburger has officially combined the parishes of St. Frances Cabrini and Our Lady of La Vang (historically, a Vietnamesespeaking community), as of Dec. 6th, 2021. Father Francis Dien Tran is now the Pastor of the combined parishes.

MASS SCHEDULE

On the weekends, the Sunday Mass in English will be at 8:30 a.m., presided over by Msgr. Albert Schifano, who likes to be called "Father Al." The Sunday Mass at 10:30 a.m. and the Saturday Anticipatory Mass at 6:00 p.m. will be in Vietnamese, presided over by Fr. Francis Dien Tran. On all Holy Days, the Mass in English will be at 8:30 a.m., presided over by Msgr. Albert Schifano. The Mass in Vietnamese on Holy Days, presided over by Fr. Francis Tran, will be at 7:30 p.m. There are no regular weekday Masses until further notice. Everyone is welcome to attend any of the Masses in either language.
