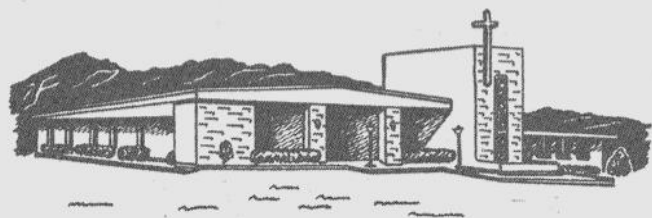

WHAT IS THIS PARISH CALLED NOW?

At the present time, the official name of our parish remains "St. Frances Cabrini Parish." However, Bishop Weisenburger has officially combined the parishes of St. Frances Cabrini and Our Lady of La Vang (historically, a Vietnamese-speaking community), as of Dec. 6th, 2021. Father Francis Dien Tran is now the Pastor of the combined parishes.

MASS SCHEDULE

On the weekends, the Sunday Mass in English will be at 8:30 a.m., presided over by Msgr. Albert Schifano, who likes to be called "Father Al." The Sunday Mass at 10:30 a.m. and the Saturday Anticipatory Mass at 6:00 p.m. will be in Vietnamese, presided over by Fr. Francis Dien Tran, who likes to be called "Father Francis." On all Holy Days, the Mass in English will be at 8:30 a.m., presided over by Fr. Al. The Mass in Vietnamese on Holy Days, presided over by Fr. Francis, will be at 7:30 p.m. There are no regular weekday Masses until further notice. **Everyone is welcome to attend any of the Masses in either language.**

MUSIC IN OUR CHURCH

At the 8:30 Sunday Masses, Michael Dolan plays guitar and sometimes the hammered dulcimer for us, and the singers are all members of the former Cabrini Choir: Martha Castleberry, Eileen Godollei, Patti McBride, David Finerson, Michael Ponce, and Michael Mueller. Some time in the new year, the Youth Choir, which sings in Vietnamese and English and is directed by Angeline Vu, will resume performing as well.
