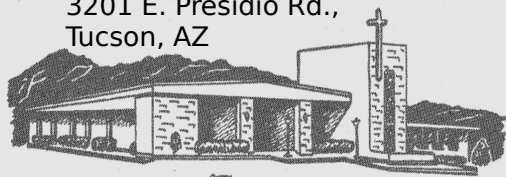

### FR. FRANCIS TO LEAVE SOCIETY FR. DOMINIC TO BECOME PASTOR

Our Pastor, Fr. Francis Tran, has been reassigned to a parish in Long Beach, California. Our new pastor will be our current Parochial Vicar, Fr. Dominic Francis. Fr. Francis will preside at his last Mass here on Sun., July 2, at 8:30 a.m. Mass, at which Fr. Al will concelebrate. There will be a farewell brunch in the Parish Hall at 9:30. There will also be a 10:30 English Mass on July 2, but everyone in our parish is invited to attend the 8:30 Mass and the brunch on July 2 to say good-bye to Fr. Francis.
