2024 IS THE YEAR OF THE DRAGON IN THE TRADITIONAL VIETNAMESE LUNAR CALENDAR. OUR PARISH WILL HAVE A LUNAR NEW YEAR FESTIVAL HERE FEB. 10-11. FESTIVAL HOURS ARE SAT., FEB. 10, 4:00 TO 10:00 P.M. AND SUN., FEB. 11 FROM 10:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M. THERE WILL BE BOOTHS IN THE PARKING LOT SELLING VIETNAMESE FOOD AND VARIOUS BEVERAGES. THERE WILL BE PERFORMANCES OF TRADITIONAL VIETNAMESE MUSIC AND DANCES, PLUS HIP-HOP AND K-POP DANCES.

ON SUNDAY THE 11TH THERE WILL BE JUST ONE MASS, AT 9:30 A.M., AT WHICH BISHOP WEISENBURGER WILL PRESIDE, ALONG WITH OUR PASTOR. EVERYONE IN THE PARISH IS INVITED. AFTER MASS, WE WILL GO OUT TO THE PARKING LOT BEHIND THE PATIO BETWEEN THE EDUCATION BLDG. AND THE HALL, WHERE THE BISHOP WILL LIGHT THE FIRECRACKERS (THERE WILL BE AN OFF-DUTY FIREFIGHTER IN ATTENDANCE). THEN WE WILL WATCH THE TRADITIONAL, VERY ENTERTAINING DRAGON DANCE, WHICH WILL DELIGHT ACTUAL CHILDREN AND THE INNER CHILD WITHIN US ALL.
