

ATTENTION, VOLUNTEERS!

As you know, fingerprint cards are one of the requirements to serve as a volunteer at our parish. In recent months, many parishes within the Diocese — including ours — have experienced a high number of rejects using the <code>ink</code> process. In an effort to reduce this situation, volunteers will have two options. Option 1: complete their initial card using the ink process. If rejected, option two will be required. Option 2: Complete an <code>electronic</code> fingerprint card. Cost and locations available at the parish office. NOTE: These procedures apply to NEW volunteers and anyone who received a recent notice that their fingerprint card has been rejectant.

DONATING \$ TO ST. VINCENT DE PAUL (SVDP)

Did you know that your cash donations to SVDP may qualify you for a tax credit on your AZ State Income Tax Return? The Arizona Qualified Charitable Organization tax credit provides for a dollar-



for-dollar reduction on your tax liability: up to \$421 for a single person; \$841 on a joint return. And your donation does not have to be made in a lump sum. 


CABRINI BIBLE STUDY
