AT ST. FRANCES CABRINI PARISH

Masses on Palm Sunday weekend, March 23-24, will follow the normal schedule, with the English Mass on Palm Sunday at 10:30 a.m. Congregation assembles before Mass on patio between Parish Hall & Ed. Bldg. for the blessing of the palms and procession to the church.

There will be Masses in Vietnamese on Holy Thursday and Good Friday at 6:00 p.m.

On Holy Saturday, there will be an Easter

Vigil Mass in English at 6:00 p.m. Fr. Al will preside, and the English Choir will sing. There will also be an Easter Vigil Mass in Vietnamese at 8:00 p.m.



On Easter Sunday, there will only be one Mass. Fr. Dominic will preside at a bilingual Mass at 10:30 a.m., at which the Vietnamese choir will sing, followed by free lunch in the Parish Hall and an Easter egg hunt for children. All parish members are invited to this Mass (fair warning, it will probably be crowded) and the festivities after it.
