CONFESSIONS are available for half an hour before each of the weekend Masses.



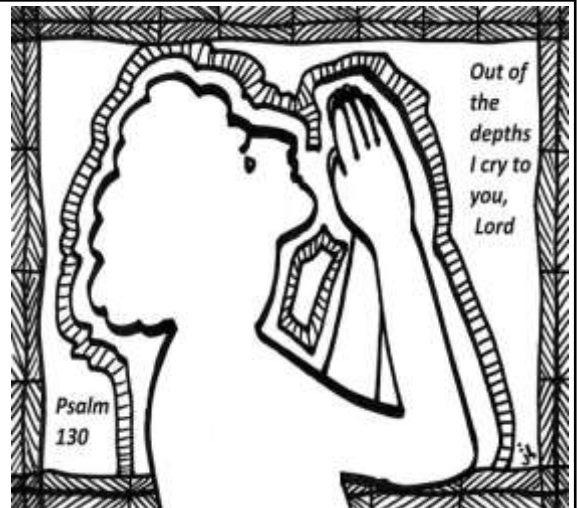
OUR PARISH AND CLERGY

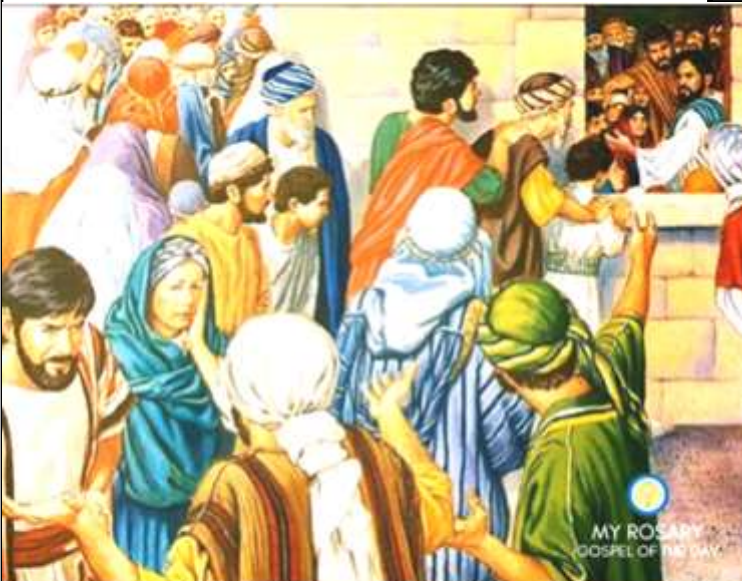
