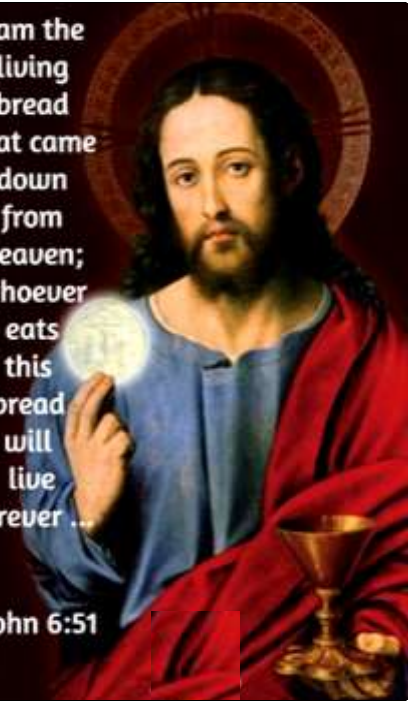

OCIA/RCIA CLASSES TO START SEPT. 12

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (formerly called the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a process for non-Catholic adults to learn more about the Catholic Church and join the Catholic faith; it is also for baptized Catholics who have not yet received their First Confession, First Communion, and/or Confirmation. If you wish to become a Catholic, or to receive any Sacraments that you have not yet received, or to be baptized into the Catholic Church as an adult, contact Deacon Charles Gallegos of this parish. Classes will begin Sept. 12 and will continue each Thursday evening, 7:00 to 8:30 p.m., until Easter, when Bishop Weisenburger will confer the Sacraments. Classes will be in English and are for those 18 years of age or older. The cost is \$50 for materials, but there is financial assistance for those who qualify. FREE CONCERT AT SAN XAVIER MISSION

Arizona Early Music will be presenting a free concert at San Xavier del Bac Mission on Wednesday, August 14 at 3:00 p.m. The concert will commemorate Venerable Padre Kino's birthday. It will feature chamber music from Padre Kino's time, performed in one of his missions with period instruments: organ, baroque violin, cornetto and sackbut (these last two are brass instruments — I had to look them up — Eileen).

The performers are from Le Consort Laurentien, a group based in Quebec, Canada. They are dedicated to the performance of chamber music from the 16th and 17th centuries.
