





Mid-Autumn Festival

Our parish will have a traditional Vietnamese Mid-Autumn Festival, also known as the Full Moon Festival (Tet Trung Thu, in Vietnamese), on Saturday, Sept. 21st. This is a festival where children have a parade, carrying paper lanterns, and look at the harvest moon. There will be a lantern decoration contest for children ages 7-12, and each child will receive a free lantern, cotton candy and snow cone. Additional foods and drinks will be sold. There will also be a lion dance and additional entertainment. Admission is free and all are invited, especially children and their parents.
