ST. VINCENT DE PAUL CASH/CHECK DONATIONS ELIGIBLE FOR TAX CREDIT

Did you know that your monetary donations to SVDP may qualify for a tax credit on your AZ tax return? The Arizona Qualified Charitable Organization Tax Credit provides for a dollar-for-dollar reduction on your tax liability: up to \$470 for a single person, \$938 on a joint return. And your donation does not have to be made in a lump sum. It can be made in smaller amounts throughout the year (even your donations made in January-April, 2025, can qualify).
