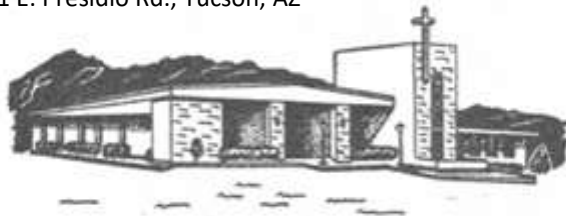

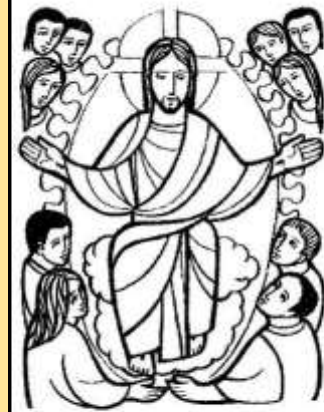

ST. FRANCES CABRINI, often called Mother Cabrini, is the patron saint of our parish as well as the patron saint of immigrants. Herself an immigrant from Italy, she was sent by the Pope to the USA in the mid-1800s to help Italian Catholic immigrants, in particular, who were often living in conditions of great poverty, despised and subject to discrimination at

that time. She became an American citizen and, at the head of the order of sisters she founded (the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus), established many soup kitchens, Catholic hospitals, orphanages and schools, working ceaselessly to alleviate suffering and lift up other people in New York, Chicago, Denver and other places. She was devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Today the Prelude sung by our choir will be a little song in her honor written by a former parish member, Dane Armijo.

The Cabrini/La Vang St. Vincent de Paul conference would like to share with our parish some statistics showing our recent work.

Over the months of July, Aug. & Sept. we made 124 home visits. Those households had 186 adults and 99 children. We delivered food to 98 of those homes. We made 16 rent payments. Finally, we paid 26 TEP bills. All of this was made possible by your generous support!!
