before each of the weekend Masses. You may also call Fr. Dominic (520-667-6066) to make an appointment.




OUR PARISH AND CLERGY

ST. VINCENT DE PAUL CASH/CHECK DONATIONS ELIGIBLE FOR TAX CREDIT

Did you know that your monetary donations to SVDP may qualify for a tax credit on your AZ tax return? The Arizona Qualified Charitable Organization Tax Credit provides for a dollar-for-dollar reduction on your tax liability: <u>up to \$470 for a single person, \$938 on a</u> <u>joint return.</u> And your donation does not have to be made in a lump sum. It can be made in smaller amounts throughout the year (even your donations made in January-April, 2025, can qualify). The credit is claimed on AZ Form 321, using Code 20768. Questions?
