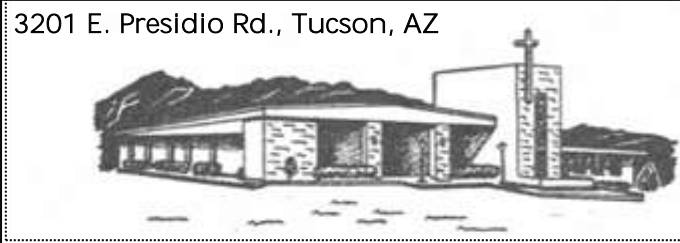

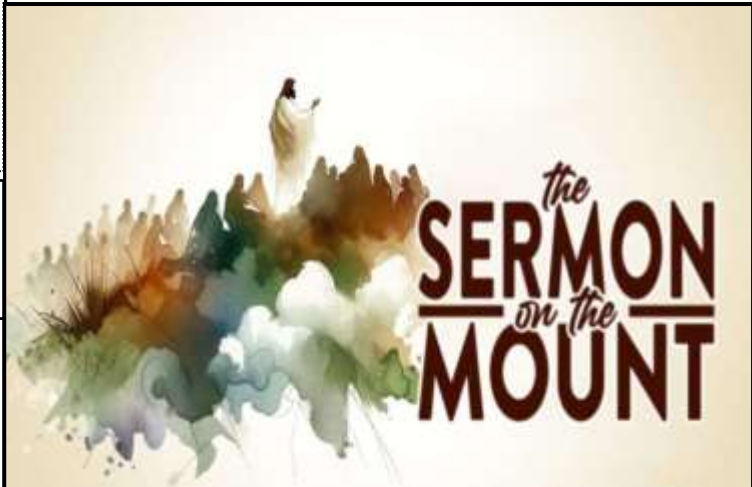
OUR PARISH AND CLERGY

DID YOU KNOW?

Arizona law allows for a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for donations made to the St. Vincent de Paul Conference here at the parish. Single filers can claim up to \$495, and couples \$987. Your contributions are subtracted from any amount you may owe, using Tax Form 321 (Code 20203). You have until April 15, 2026 to make your donation for 2025. THE COMPLETE READINGS FOR THIS SUNDAY, FEB. 1st, MAY BE FOUND ON PAGES 65-67 OF THE BREAKING BREAD MISSAL. IT IS THE 4th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME.

Today's Gospel Reading, recording the Sermon on the Mount, contains the Beatitudes, in which Jesus tells us who will be blessed by God.

When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain, and after he had sat down, his disciples came to him. He began to teach them, saying:
"Blessed are the poor in spirit,
for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
Blessed are they who mourn,
for they will be comforted.
Blessed are the meek,
for they will inherit the land.
Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for righteousness,
for they will be satisfied.
Blessed are the merciful,
for they will be shown mercy.
Blessed are the clean of heart,
for they will see God.
Blessed are the peacemakers,
for they will be called children of God.
Blessed are they who are persecuted for the sake of righteousness,
for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
Blessed are you when they insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you falsely because of me. Rejoice and be glad,
for your reward will be great in heaven."

JAMES MISKO'S ORDINATION AND INSTALLATION

Pope Leo XIV appointed James Misko as the 8th Bishop of the Diocese of Tucson on Dec. 22, 2025. The celebration of his Ordination and Installation as Bishop will begin on Thursday, Feb. 19th with the beautiful liturgy of Solemn Vespers at 5:30 p.m. in St. Augustine Cathedral. This event is open to all, and an opportunity for the people of our Diocese to unite in prayer and thanksgiving with Bishop-Elect Misko. On Friday, Feb. 20th, his official Ordination and Installation will take place in the Cathedral at 2:00 p.m. While this portion of the celebration is by invitation only, everyone is invited and encouraged to attend virtually, as it will be live-streamed for all to witness on diocesetucson.org and on Facebook.
