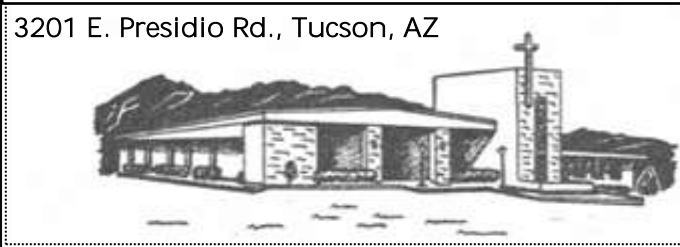

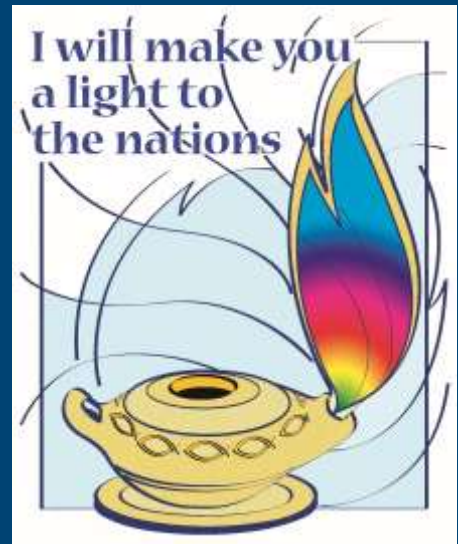
OUR PARISH AND CLERGY

BISHOP-ELECT JAMES MISKO

Pope Leo XIV appointed James Misko as the 8th bishop of the Diocese of Tucson on Dec. 22, 2025; his ordination as our Bishop will take place at St. Augustine Cathedral on Feb. 20, 2026. He has lived most of his life in Texas, and has a degree in Communications from St. Edward's University in Austin. Employed in the restaurant industry for several years, he eventually worked his way up to Managing Partner. At the age of 30, he entered the seminary, and earned an M.A. in Theological Studies as well as a Master of Divinity degree from the University of St. Thomas and St. Mary's Seminary in Houston. Ordained a priest in 2007, he served in 3 Texas parishes as parochial vicar and pastor. In 2019, he was appointed Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia of the Diocese of Austin, and became Diocesan Administrator of the Archdiocese of Galveston-Houston in March of 2025. Bishop-elect Misko speaks fluid Spanish and is an avid golfer who also enjoys cycling, traveling, gardening, cooking, and visiting local restaurants and cafés.

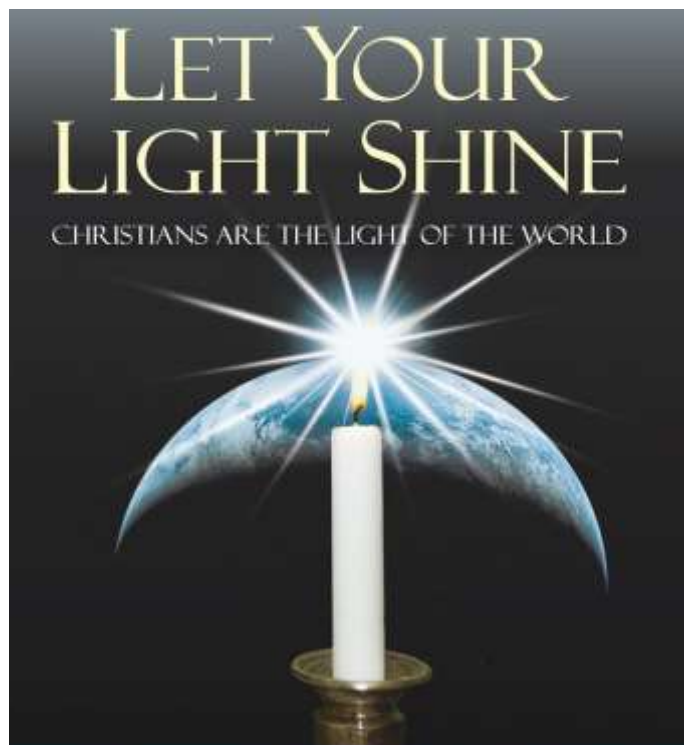
