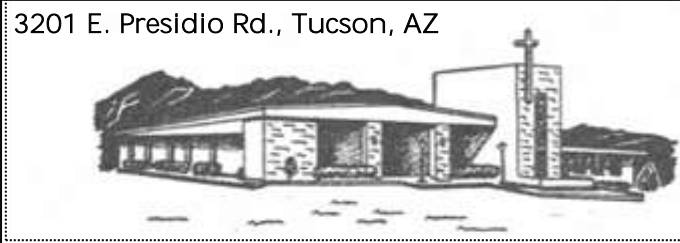

JAMES MISKO'S ORDINATION AND INSTALLATION

Pope Leo XIV appointed James Misko as the 8th Bishop of the Diocese of Tucson on Dec. 22, 2025. The celebration of his Ordination and Installation as Bishop will begin on Thursday, Feb. 19th with the beautiful liturgy of Solemn Vespers at 5:30 p.m. in St. Augustine Cathedral. This event is open to all, and an opportunity for the people of our Diocese to unite in prayer and thanksgiving with Bishop-Elect Misko. On Friday, Feb. 20th, his official Ordination and Installation will take place in the Cathedral at 2:00 p.m. While this portion of the celebration is by invitation only, everyone is invited and encouraged to attend virtually, as it will be live-streamed for all to witness on diocesetucson.org and on Facebook.

ANNUAL PARISH LUNAR NEW YEAR CELEBRATION SOON

The Vietnamese Lunar New Year will be celebrated in our parish Feb. 14-15. Festival booths will be open in the parking lot on Sat. the 14th from 4 to 10:00 p.m., and on Sun. the 15th from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Delicious Vietnamese foods and various beverages, including boba tea and beer, will be sold. This is a fund-raiser for the parish. There will only be one Mass on Sunday, Feb. 15, a bilingual Mass at 9:30 a.m., at which Bishop Kicanas will preside. After the Mass there will be free entertainment in the parking lot, including songs, firecrackers and the traditional lion dance.

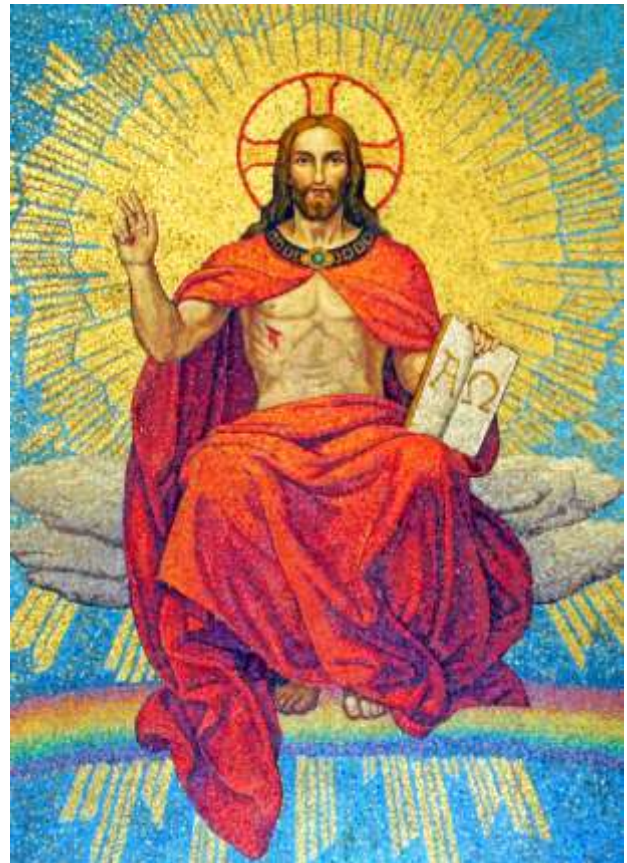

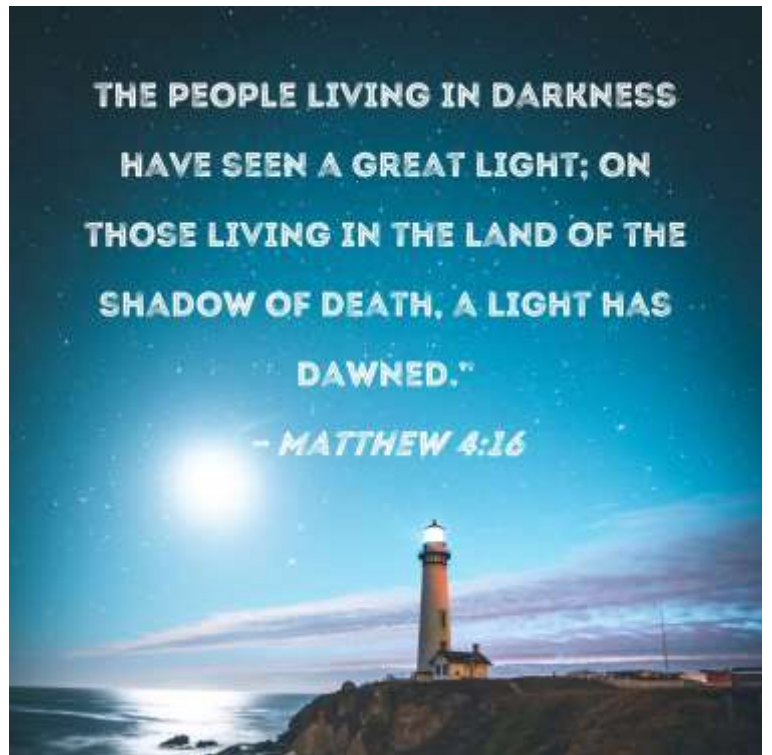
