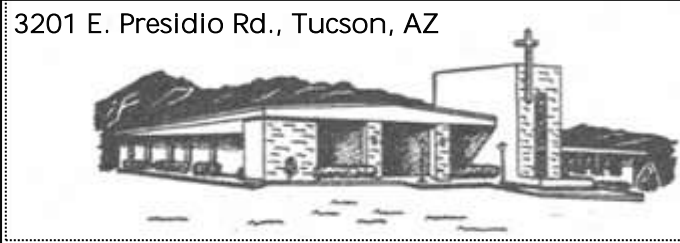

**OUR PARISH AND CLERGY**

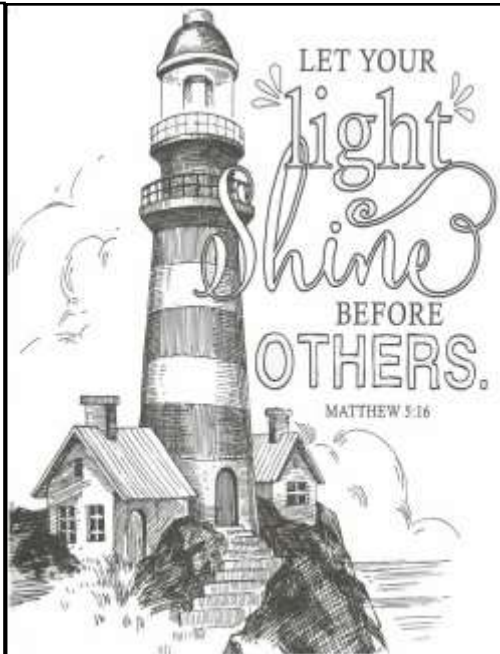

#### JAMES MISKO’S ORDINATION AND INSTALLATION

Pope Leo XIV appointed James Misko as the 8th Bishop of the Diocese of Tucson on Dec. 22, 2025. The celebration of his Ordination and Installation as Bishop will begin on Thursday, Feb. 19th with the beautiful liturgy of Solemn Vespers at 5:30 p.m. in St. Augustine Cathedral. This event is open to all, and an opportunity for the people of our Diocese to unite in prayer and thanksgiving with Bishop-Elect Misko. On Friday, Feb. 20th, his official Ordination and Installation will take place in the Cathedral at 2:00 p.m. While this portion of the celebration is by invitation only, everyone is invited and encouraged to attend virtually, as it will be live-streamed for all to witness on [diocesetucson.org](http://diocesetucson.org) and on Facebook.

#### DID YOU KNOW?

Arizona law allows for a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for donations made to the St. Vincent de Paul Conference here at the parish. Single filers can claim up to \$495, and couples \$987. Your contributions are subtracted from any amount you may owe, using Tax Form 321 (Code 20203). You have until April 15, 2026 to make your donation for 2025.
