DID YOU KNOW?

Arizona law allows for a dollar-for-dollar tax credit for donations made to the St. Vincent de Paul Conference here at the parish. Single filers can claim up to \$495, and couples \$987. Your contributions are subtracted from any amount you may owe, using Tax Form 321 (Code 20203). You have until April 15, 2026 to make your donation for 2025. Please consult your tax advisor for further details.
