#### OUR PARISH AND CLERGY

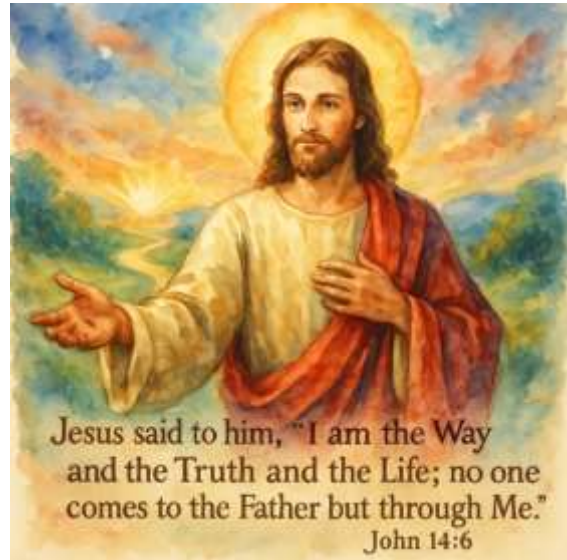
