
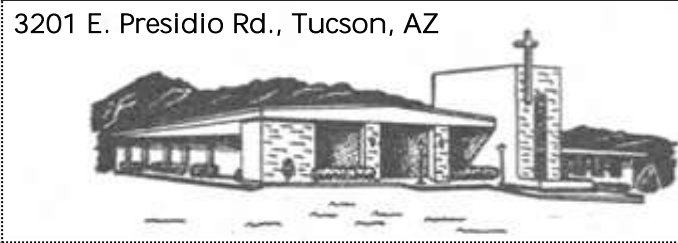

A SPECIAL SECOND COLLECTION WILL BE TAKEN UP TODAY to help support the Redemptorist Fathers of the Vice Province of Extra Patriam, headquartered in Houston, TX, which provides clergy for our parish and many others. The Redemptorist Order (the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer), founded in Italy in 1732 by St. Alphonsus Liguori, has become an international order of priests, brothers and nuns serving the world. The Vice Province of Extra Patriam was created to work with Vietnamese Catholics who came to the USA after the fall of Saigon in 1975. When St. Frances Cabrini Parish of Tucson was about to close due to its shrinking congregation, it was merged by Bishop Weisenberger with Our Lady of La Vang Parish of Tucson. Fr. Francis Dien Tran became our Pastor, followed by Fr. Dominic Hao Pham, both members of the Redemptorist order, as is Brother Peter Duc Nguyen.
