OUR PARISH AND CLERGY

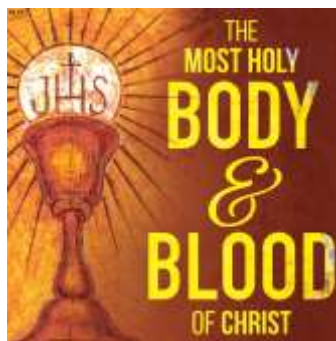
