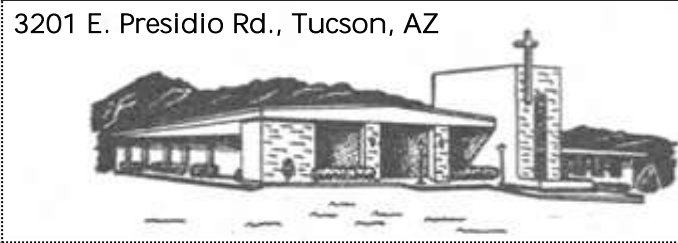

Note: We have a 12:15 bilingual Youth Mass when children's religion classes are in session. Youth Classes and the 12:15 Mass will resume August 23.

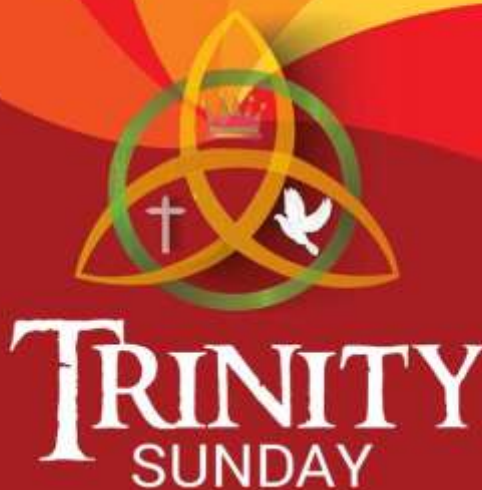
OUR PARISH AND CLERGY

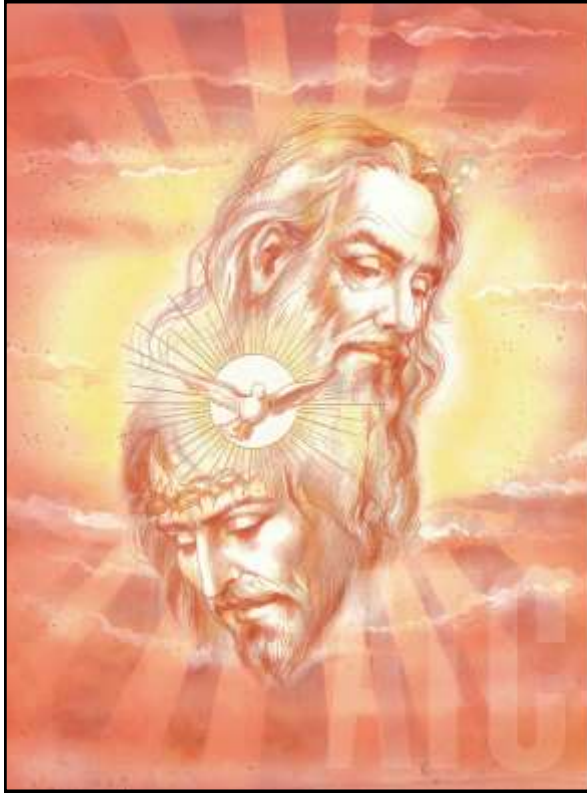
