WHAT IS OCIA/RCIA?

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (formerly called the Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) is the process, established by the Universal Church, for individuals to become Catholic and receive the sacraments of initiation — Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist. This initiation process also involves a parish community experiencing a renewal in faith as it prepares and welcomes new members into the Church. The Rite speaks of conversion as a "spiritual journey." Centered on fostering a deep relationship with Jesus and the Church he founded, this journey takes place through distinct stages over a period suitable to bring about a thorough catechesis, significant experience of the parish community, and commitment to the liturgical and moral life of the Catholic faithful.

Who is OCIA for?

1. Adults 18 and over who are one of the following:
2. Persons in need of the Sacrament of Baptism;
3. Persons baptized in another Christian tradition who desire to become Catholic;
4. Persons baptized Catholic who desire the completion of their Sacraments — First Communion and/or Confirmation;
5. Persons interested in learning more about the Catholic Faith.
6. All are welcome to join us to learn more about the Catholic Faith.

Classes begin Tuesday, August 18, 2026 and continue to meet every Tuesday from 6:30 to 8:00 p.m., with exceptions as announced in class. Cost is \$50 per person for materials. There is financial assistance for those who qualify. Interviews will begin immediately prior to the first classes.
