OUR PARISH AND CLERGY

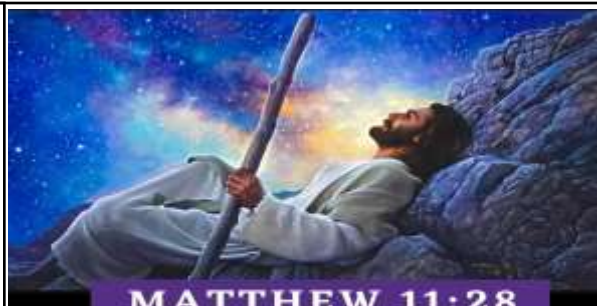

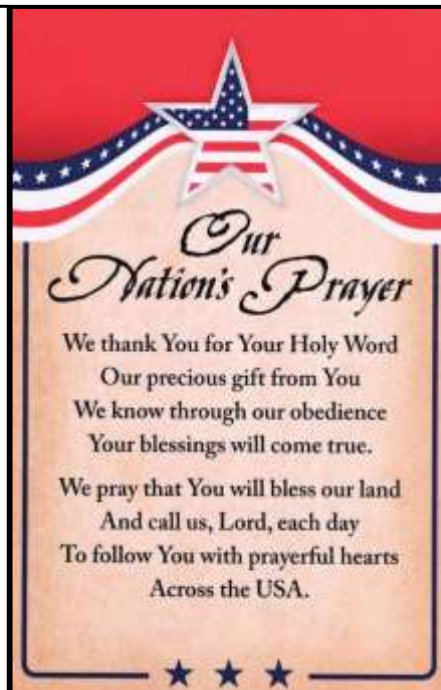
