At long last, after many planning delays, the renovation of our church building has begun. **All Masses will be held in the Parish Hall** until the completion of the church renovation; it will probably take at least 9 to 10 months. A new main entrance and vestibule, plus restrooms, will be added to the west side of the building. There will space within the vestibule where parents can take crying babies, and we will also have a new sacristy, and another small room where altar servers can change. A sprinkling system in case of fire will be installed. The flooring in the entire church will be replaced and the inside of the church will be repainted. The altar, the choir area, and almost everything else will be put back in the same places. We all look forward to seeing the results.

The parish welcomes contributions to the Building Fund. Money in the parish savings account has allowed us to start renovation, but prices of everything have gone up since this project was first envisioned, so additional money is needed. Please be as generous as you can, and pray for the successful completion of the project.

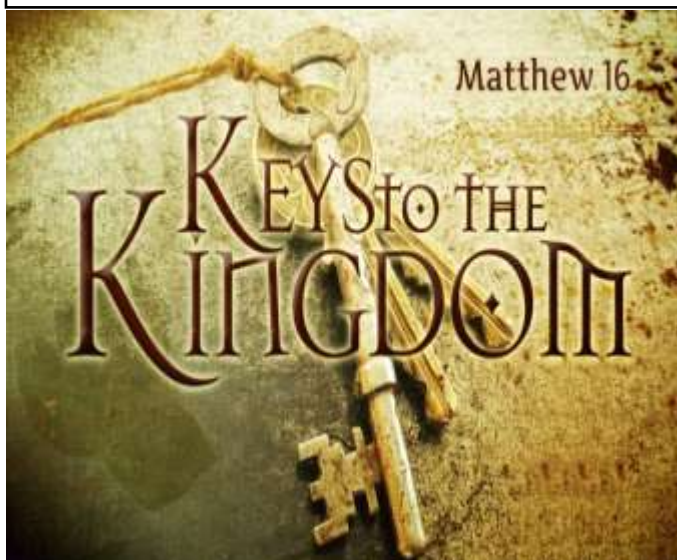
The collection total for Aug. 15-16, 2026 is \$3,907. Thank you for your contributions to help support our parish.

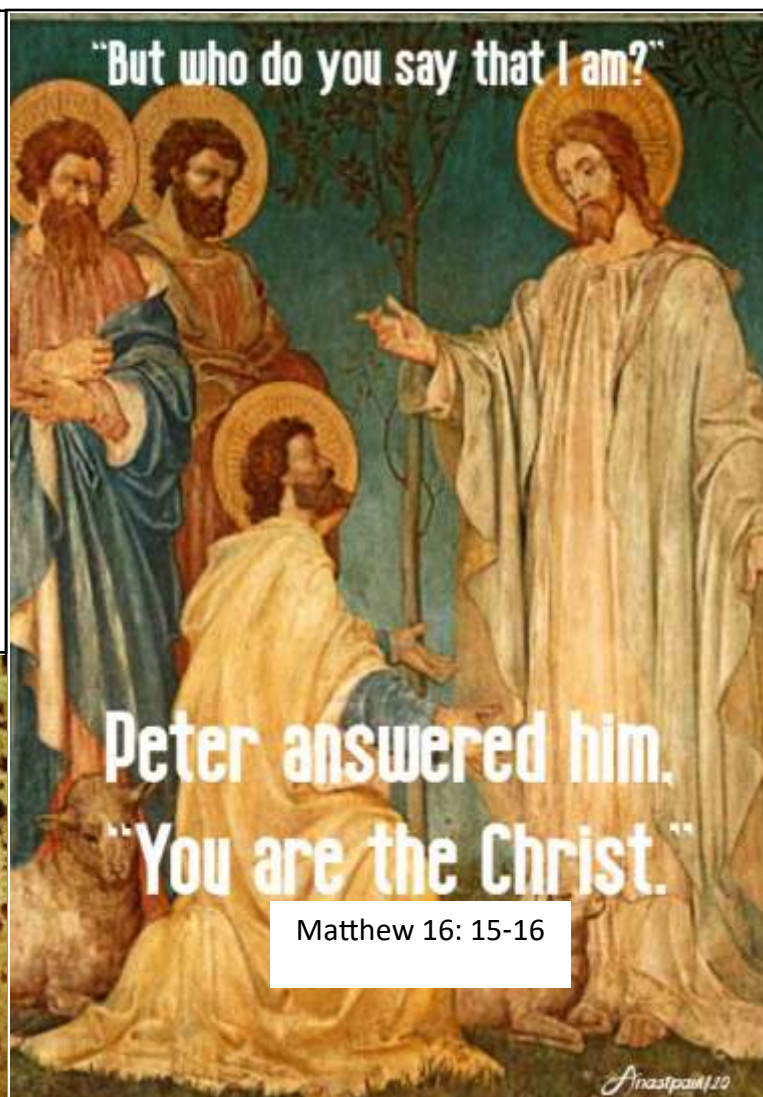
