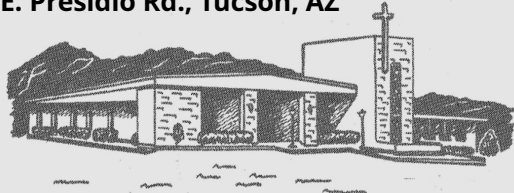

The complete Readings for today, on which we celebrate the 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time, may be found in 204-206 of the Breaking Bread. The First Reading (Isaiah 5: 1-7), the Responsorial Psalm (selected from Psalm 80) and the Gospel all use metaphorical language about vineyards, vines, grapes and their growers. In the Gospel, Jesus tells a parable about wicked tenants who want to keep all the produce of the vineyard for themselves, and who even kill the son of the vineyard owner to try to keep possession of it.



CHURCH UNDER RENOVATION; FUNDS NEEDED

The renovation of our church building has begun. **All**

Masses will be held in the Parish Hall until the completion of the renovation; it will probably take at least until June.

A new main entrance and vestibule, plus restrooms, will be added to the west side of the building. The beautiful stained glass windows on the west side will be saved but differently placed. There will be space within the vestibule where parents can take crying babies, and we will also have a new sacristy, and another small room where altar servers can change. There will be an outdoor shrine of Our Lady of La Vang at the far west side of the parking lot, facing the new entrance. There will also be changes to the south side of the church. The flooring in the entire church will be replaced and the inside of the church will be repainted. A sprinkling system in case of fire will be installed. The altar, the choir area, and almost everything else will be put back in the same places. Posters in the back of the Hall depict some of the changes.

Money in the parish savings account has allowed us to start the project, but prices of everything have gone up since it was first envisioned, so additional money is needed.
